विषय: जनपद मे शीत कालीन ऋतु मे वायु प्रदूषण की रोकथाम हेतु किये जाने वाले कार्यों के सम्बन्ध मे।

कृपया उपरोक्त विषयक आप अवगत है कि शीत ऋतु मे दिल्ली एन0सी0आर0 क्षेत्र की वायु गुणता adverse meteorological condition, स्थानीय स्तर पर जनित होने वाले प्रदूषणकारी कारकों व अन्य प्रान्तों से आने वाले प्रदूषण के कारण अत्यधिक खराब हो जाती है। मा0 सर्वोच्च न्यायालय द्वारा रिट पिटीशन संख्या 13029/1985 एम0सी0 मेहता बनाम यूनियन ऑफ इण्डिया एवं अन्य तथा न्यायालय के आदेशों के क्रम मे मुख्य सचिव महोदय, उ0प्र0 शासन द्वारा समय-समय पर पराली जलाये जाने से होने वाले प्रदूषण, निर्माणाधीन परियोजनाओं व धूल मिटटी आदि के अन्य श्रोतों से डस्ट उत्सर्जन की रोकथाम हेतु Anti Smog Gun की स्थापना, उधोगों मे स्वीकृत ईंधन के प्रयोग, हॉट-स्पॉट प्रबन्धन आदि के सम्बन्ध मे निर्देशित किया गया है।

गत वर्षों की भौति आवश्यक है कि जनपद स्तर पर वायु गुणता पर प्रतिकूल प्रभाव डालने वाले सभी कारकों पर प्रभावी नियंत्रण किये जाने हेतु कार्यवाही की जाये। यद्यपि वायु प्रदूषण की रोकथाम हेतु कार्य समस्त जनपद मे किया जाना है परन्तु वायु प्रदूषण के कारकों यदा यातायात, निर्माण कार्य, कूड़ा प्रबन्धन, औधोगिक उत्सर्जन, धूल मिटटी आदि के उत्सर्जन के आधार पर जनपद मे चिन्हित हॉट-स्पॉट के प्रबन्धन पर विशेष ध्यान दिया जाना आवश्यक

है। क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय, उ०प्र० प्रदूषण नियंत्रण बोर्ड, गाजियाबाद द्वारा प्रेषित आख्यानानुसार जनपद मे वायु प्रदूषण के दृष्टिगत निम्न 10 प्रमुख हॉट-स्पॉट चिन्हित किये गये है:-

उपरोक्त वर्णित हॉट-स्पॉट मे वायु प्रदूषण पर प्रभावी रोकथाम किये जाने हेतु कार्य योजना पत्र के साथ संलग्न कर आपको इस अनुरोध के साथ प्रेषित की जा रही है कि उक्त कार्य योजनानुसार अपने विभाग से सम्बन्धित कार्यों को नियत समयावधि मे सम्पादित किया जाना सुनिश्चित करें, जिससे कि स्थानीय स्तर पर वायु प्रदूषण कारकों मे कमी लायी जा सके।

हॉट-स्पॉट प्रबन्धन के अतिरिक्त पूर्ण जनपद मे वायु प्रदूषण के कारकों पर प्रभावी नियंत्रण किये जाने हेतु विभागों द्वारा निम्नानुसार कार्य सुनिश्चित किये जायेगे:

1- Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam/Nagar Pallika Parishad/Nagar Panchyat/DPRO
➤ To Increase frequency of mechanized cleaning in the city.
➤ Sprinkling of water on road and wherever required.

- To identify road stretches with high dust generation.
- To check and ensure compliance of Environmental Norms on road construction /Storm Water Drain construction /sewage line etc. being carried out by contractors of Ghaziabad Nagar Nigam/Nagar Pallika Parishad/Nagar Panchyat/DPRO
- To check and stop burning of rubber /plastic waste /other waste in public area.
- To constitute Quick Response Teams of officer/official for stoppage of garbage burning/biomass burning.
- To ensure proper covering of all the vehicles carrying municipal solid waste.
- Night patrolling for the above said points may also be done by constituting the teams in their respective jurisdiction.
- To prohibit the use of single use plastic as the mandate of Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan.
- Compliance of action plans on the identified pollution hotspots in the city.
- There should be an enhanced vigilance at sources such as garbage and construction waste dumping. All technologies to control dust emission, including smog-guns, dust suppressant polymers should be used extensively during this period.
- The solid waste dumping issues have to be addressed on priority.
- To ensure removal & scientific disposal of C&D waste
- To identify and curb operation of illegal industries in unauthorised areas.
- To identify and curb unauthorised collection of plastic, rubber and other waste material by scrap dealers to avoid instances of garbage burning.
- To ensure regulation of DG sets under their jurisdictional area.
- To ensure submission of undertaking regarding adherence to the prescribed norms / guidelines for dust management large construction projects
- To ensure implementation of orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding prohibition/ restriction in the sale and use of fire crackers in NCR.
- Setting up of control room for complaints related to air pollution and immediate redressal of complaints received on Sameer, Swach Vayu, Twitter etc.

2- Police Department:-

- To enlist Traffic hot-spots in the district and release list and advisory accordingly.
- To deploy additional man power/civil defence volunteers to ensure smooth traffic flow at identified Traffic hot-spots.
- To impound diesel vehicles older than 10 years and petrol vehicles older than 15 years in compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court's order.
- To ensure that non-destined vehicles used bypasses/peripheral expressways.
- To keep strict vigilance and no tolerance for visible emissions - stop plying of visibly polluting vehicles by impounding/fine
- To keep strict vigilance and enforcement of PUC norms.

- To ensure stoppage of encroachment on footpath.
- To check and resolve issues such as congestion & unusual dust emission due to traffic /parking.
- Compliance of action plans on the identified pollution hotspots in the city.
- To ensure implementation of orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding prohibition/ restriction in the sale and use of fire crackers in NCR.
- To ensure immediate redressal of complaints received on Sameer, Swach Vayu, Twitter etc.

3- Ghaziabad Development Authority/Awas Vikas Parishad/UPSIDA/Jal Nigam

- To ensure implementation of directions of Hon'ble NGT/Environmental laws /guidelines of MoEF at construction sites. Compliance of action plans on the identified pollution hotspots in the city.
- There should be an enhanced vigilance at sources such as garbage dumping. All technologies to control dust emission, including smog-guns, should be used extensively during this period.
- To ensure removal & scientific disposal of C&D waste
- To ensure regulation of DG sets under their jurisdictional area.
- To identify and curb operation of illegal industries in unauthorised areas.
- To identify and curb unauthorised collection of plastic, rubber and other waste material by scrap dealers to avoid instances of garbage burning.
- To ensure submission of undertaking regarding adherence to the prescribed norms / guidelines for dust management large construction projects
- To ensure immediate redressal of complaints received on Sameer, Swach Vayu, Twitter etc.

- To ensure no illegal parking in their jurisdiction.
- To stop illegal auto /vehicles.
- Compliance of action plans on the identified pollution hotspots in the city.
- There should be an enhanced vigilance at sources such as use of illegal fuels.
- To ensure immediate redressal of complaints received on Sameer, Swach Vayu, Twitter etc.

5- Agriculture Department

- To ensure monitoring of crop residue burning.
- To conduct awareness programme among farmers involving village Panchayats.
- To explore possibility installation of biomass power project, bio manure.
- Compliance of action plans on the identified pollution hotspots in the city.
- There should be an enhanced vigilance at sources such as stubble burning

- To Increase frequency of mechanized cleaning of road.
- Sprinkling of water on road.
- To provide adequate u-turn to reduce for returning on destined vehicles (in case of congestion)
- To make roads pothole free for smooth flow of traffic.
- Compliance of action plans on the identified pollution hotspots in city.
- There should be an enhanced vigilance and use of technologies to control dust emission, including smog-guns, should be used extensively during this period.
- To ensure removal & scientific disposal of C&D waste
- To ensure immediates redressal of complaints received on Sameer, Swach Vayu, Twitter etc.

14- Mining Department

- To take action against non complying mining activities/stone crushers/brick kilns in coordination with District Administration.
- To ensure installation and vigilance and use of technologies to control dust emission, including smog-guns, should be used extensively during this period.

15- District Information Office


- To circulate all communications and information on District Whats app group for immediate information to all concerned.

16- Fire Department

- To facilitate departments in controlling fire incidences
- To use fire brigades for water sprinkling at sensitive locations during severe/severe+ air quality under Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP).

Also, details of daily actions taken by all concerned departments to be sent by 4:00 PM daily on format annexed as **Annexure B**.
